




Communication is the expression, interpretation, and sometimes nedotiation of meaning with a purpose in a diven context. Dr. Bill VanPatten

Communication is the expression, interpretation, and sometimes negotiation of meaning with a purpose in a given context.

meaning - information, propositional content, intent

expression - some type of production

interpretation - comprehension

context = participants, setting, purpose

negotiation = clarification, confirmation, co-construction of discourse







You can't force the quality of output to be equal to the quality of input.


You can squeeze out a little bit of water. But once the sponge is full, the water will overflow out!
